Hercules Aircraft Load Planner

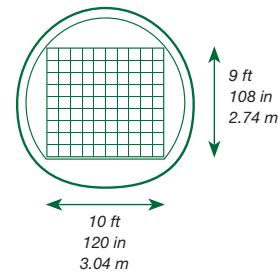

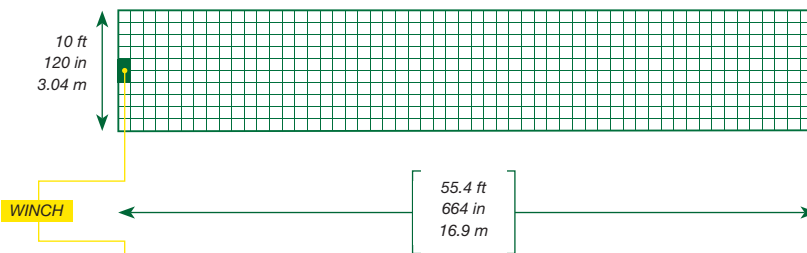
L-382 Hercules

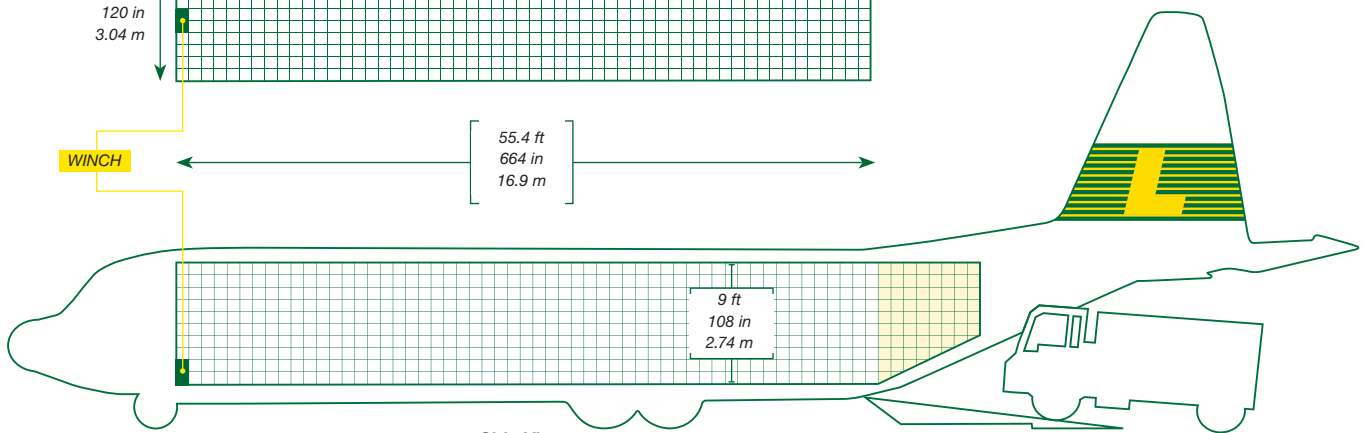
Rear View Cargo Profile

Hercules Capabilities Include:

- Accommodates 8 non-contoured pallets or containers with dimensions of 108 inches in length, 88 inches wide, and 96 inches high for pallet positions 1 through 7; the 8th position is 108 inches in length, 88 inches wide, and 76 inches high
- Maximum payload is 48,000 lbs
- Straight-in loading through rear cargo ramp door
- Truck-bed height loading; ramp is adjustable to any position
- Drive-on, drive-off loading for vehicles and heavy equipment (rolling stock)
- Capable of transporting Connex boxes
- Self-contained auxiliary power; minimum ground support required
- for aircraft systems, offloading, and onloading
- Self-contained winch for loading/unloading cargo
- Aircraft can back up under its own power
- Short and unpaved runway takeoff and landing

The unique capabilities of our Hercules aircraft allow us to fly oil dispersant and land in remote areas without runways or roads. A custom designed airborne dispersant delivery system is installed in the aircraft and deployed at low altitudes to assist in control and cleanup efforts.

Lynden Air Cargo planes flew several aerial oil dispersant missions in support of the Deepwater Horizon response efforts in the Gulf of Mexico and we have stepped in to support customers with a variety of containment and cleanup projects all over the world.

We can carry materials and supplies to challenging locations anywhere. Our years of experience and expertise help you quickly and effectively contain a spill site and restore marine habitats and environments.

Lynden Air Cargo is an EPA-certified waste transporter, capable of carrying all types of hazardous loads including contaminated soils, fuel, oily waste and PCBs. We have flown propane, flammable liquids and other dangerous cargo to assist in many emergencies and natural disasters.
