RE: Notice of Decrease in Fuel Surcharge

Dear Valued Customers:

Alaska Marine Lines has filed with the Surface Transportation Board to decrease the fuel surcharge from 4.0% to 2.0% on shipments to, from and between points in Western Alaska as defined in tariff STB AKMR 316, Rule 345, covering the ports of Bethel, Dillingham, Naknek, Nome, Kotzebue, and villages serviced through those ports. This decrease becomes effective on January 17, 2016. This change does not affect rates or fuel surcharge in Dutch Harbor, Aleutian Islands or Kodiak areas.

We continue to monitor fuel prices on a daily basis and will adjust the fuel surcharge when necessary.

We appreciate your business and your understanding with regard to fluctuating fuel prices.
