## AML Notification of General Rate Increase Central Alaska

Dear Valued Customer,

Alaska Marine Lines has filed with the Surface Transportation Board for a 3.75% General Rate Increase on shipments to, from and between Central Alaska and Prince William Sound locations including Anchorage, Fairbanks, Whittier, Valdez and Cordova. This increase will become effective on December 15, 2019.

Additionally, effective January 12, 2020, Alaska Marine Lines will implement a terminal charge for shipments moving to or from Central Alaska destinations, including Anchorage, Fairbanks or Whittier, to address the increasing costs associated with terminal maintenance and improvements, as well as environmental regulatory compliance. The charges will be as follows:

Northbound dry/non-temperature controlled cargo: \$75 per container or platform

Northbound temperature controlled cargo: \$100 per container

Northbound vehicle bookings, including roll-on/roll-off machinery: \$25 per piece

Southbound dry/non-temperature controlled cargo: \$20 per container or platform

Southbound temperature controlled cargo: \$40 per container

Southbound vehicle bookings, including roll-on/roll-off machinery: \$10 per piece
