WHARFAGE CHARGE INCREASE
AND FACILITIES SECURITY CHARGE

Dear Valued Customer:

The State of Hawaii Department of Transportation, Harbors Division has announced wharfage fee increases to be implemented over the next two years. A 17.0% increase over the presently effective wharfage charges will take effect on February 1, 2017. This increase is scheduled to be followed by an increase of 15.0% effective October 1, 2017, and a third increase of 15.0% effective July 1, 2018.

In general the February 2017 change will result in increases of approximately \$15.00 - \$30.00 per container on domestic Honolulu freight and \$32.00 - \$64.00 on domestic Neighbor Island freight. Wharfage rates for breakbulk cargo will also be adjusted by the percentage amount of the increases as they occur.

The State of Hawaii has also announced that it will implement a new "Facilities Security Charge" of \$15.00 per container or load for Oahu and \$22.50 per container or load for Neighbor Island shipments effective February 1, 2017. This charge will also increase this October and again next July.

Aloha Marine Lines will pass through these increases and new State fees as they occur. We appreciate your understanding as we pass on these government fees.
