Delivery Driver Information Sheet

Delivery Appointment Required

24 hours prior to arrival call **800-326-8346** to set up appointment time.
When you call, please have the following information ready:

- A. Truck # and company
- B. Driver Name
- C. Pre-shipment Entry / Booking # (PSE #), example: CB04, HE45
- D. Final Destination of Load, example: Anchorage, Fairbanks, etc.
- E. PO#, load# or pro# that may apply
- F. Flatbed or Container freight.

Location

Seattle Service Center-Hours of Operation Monday-Friday 7 a.m. – 5 p.m.
After hours appointments available for certain cargoes. Please ask when you call in.

From I-5, southbound:

Take exit #163 and follow signs to West Seattle Bridge. Cross over bridge and take Delridge Way exit, staying in the far right lane. Make soft right at the light and continue to the next light at six-way intersection. Proceed straight thru the light following the sign for West Marginal Way SW. AML container receiving, including vehicles, machinery, building materials (breakbulk) in on the left at 5600 and less-than-containerload receiving is on the right at 5615.

From I-5, northbound:

Take exit #156, Highway 599 northbound. Follow 599 until end of freeway at the light. Continue straight thru light and road will veer under the 1st Ave Bridge thru another light. Turn right at the next light (3rd one since end of freeway) at base of large hill. Proceed northbound onto West Marginal Way SW with 5615 on the left (less-than-container loads) and 5600 (vehicles, machinery, building materials, breakbulk) on the right.

From I-90:

Continue on I-90 to I-5, going southbound – follow directions listed above for I-5 southbound by taking exit #163 and continuing from there.

Arrival at Terminal

For both 5600 and 5615, proceed onto the terminal and pulling forward in the designated lines. Take all paperwork, including PSE/booking number into the appropriate office and check in. All freight must be clearly labeled with Consignee name and destination.

Flatbed shipments to be routed via the ARM- BARGE service cannot include items or packages (pallets, boxes, crates, etc.) that cannot be properly secured for safe transit.

If such items are determined that safe securement is not possible, these items will be transported separated from the tendered shipment at an additional charge.
