Alaska Marine Lines Notification of General Rate Increase Southeast Alaska

Dear Valued AML Customers,

Alaska Marine Lines has filed with the Surface Transportation Board for a general rate increase on shipments to, from and within Southeast Alaska and including Yukon, Canada; the increase is 4.8%. This increase will become effective on January 30, 2022.

Like many companies, widespread inflation and rising costs are something that impact AML and necessitate this increase. Labor shortages, additional regulation, and increased expenses for maintaining vessels, equipment, and facilities are all factors that directly add to our operating costs. Southeast Alaska is an expensive and challenging region to serve, with many small communities spread out over hundreds of miles, but we remain committed to providing dependable transportation service to the region. We continuously work to improve processes and increase efficiencies, and fortunately we were able to keep our Southeast Alaska general rate increase lower than that of other major water carriers serving the state.

Our service partners have notified us that local trucking and other ancillary charges will also be increased. These increases will vary by location, and will become effective on December 1, 2021.
