**ALASKA MARINE LINES, INC.**

Except as otherwise specifically provided, rates and charges in this Tariff are hereby increased as follows (See Notes 1 through 4):

NOTE 1: SECTIONS ONE THROUGH SEVEN AND NINE ARE INCREASED AS FOLLOWS:

All rates and charges are increased three and seventy five one-hundredths (3.75%) percent. To arrive at such increased rate or charge, multiply the rate or charge by 1.0375. Fractions of less than 1/2 cent will be dropped. Fractions of 1/2 cent or more will be increased to the next whole cent. For rates in dollars, fractions less than .50 will be dropped and fractions of .50 or more will be rounded to the next whole dollar.

NOTE 2: Where the rate or charge is published in dollars and cents, apply the equivalent in cents.
