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### Certificate of Inspection

The Senior Deckhand shall be designated in writing by the Master with a copy retained on board the vessel. The Senior Deckhand should be trained and qualified in accordance with the guidance in Navigation and Vessel Inspection Circular no. 1-91.

Total useable load is 12,574 pounds, passengers and cargo. Fixed aircraft style seating must be installed for each passenger carried. All cargo must be properly secured. All hazardous cargo shall be carried in accordance with 49 CFR Table 172.101(9a).

If the vessel is away from the dock, or passengers are on board or have access to the vessel for a period exceeding 12 hours in a 24 hour period an alternate crew shall be provided.

This vessel has been granted a five year fresh water service drydock interval in accordance with 46 CFR 176.600; vessel exposed to salt water less than three (3) months in a twelve (12) month period. Notify cognizant OCMI as soon as a change in status occurs.
