Stability Review

Ref: (a) Your letter dated 15 July 1981

Gentlemen:

Enclosures (1) through (3) are approved subject to the construction, installation, testing and workmanship being satisfactory to the cognizant Officer in Charge, Marine Inspection.

The stability of subject vessel has been reviewed with respect to loadline assignment. The subject vessel has adequate intact stability for limited operating conditions in ocean service for a loadline draft of 9'-5", provided the following conditions are achieved to:

1. The vertical center of gravity of the cargo above the main deck shall not exceed the following values:

Draft (ft.)

VCG of Cargo above the Main Deck (ft.)

8'-11" and below

15.0

- 2. The maximum height of deck cargo shall not exceed twice the height of the cargo's center of gravity (VCG) above the main deck.
- 3. No bulk liquid or ballast may be carried.
- 4. The vessel must be operated in accordance with the loading conditions 2.0 and 3.0 of enclosure (1). A stamped copy of enclosure (1) must be provided to the cognizant Officer in Charge, Marine Inspection for placement aboard the vessel.

The above restrictions (1) through (4) shall be placed on or attached to the Load Line Certificate.
