AML Notification of General Rate Increase Central Alaska

Dear Valued Customer,

Alaska Marine Lines has filed with the Surface Transportation Board for a general rate increase of 7.5%, effective December 11, 2022. This filing applies to STB AKMR tariff 314C, excluding commodity items 2500, 2539, and 2539.1 (household goods). Additionally, Rule 942 (Terminal Charge) rates will be increased as follows:

- Northbound Dry Cargo: \$100.00 to \$205.00 per container
- Temperature Controlled Cargo: \$100.00 to \$230.00 per container
- Northbound Vehicles: \$20.00 to \$75.00 per vehicle
- Southbound Dry Cargo: \$25.00 to \$70.00 per container or platform
- Southbound Temperature Controlled Cargo: \$35.00 to \$70.00 per container
- Southbound Vehicles: \$10.00 to \$75.00 per vehicle

Local trucking and other accessorial charges in STB AKMR tariff 100A will also be adjusted on the same date. These increases are necessary in order to continue to provide the consistent and reliable level of essential service that our customers and communities rely on.
