AML Notification of General Rate Increase Dutch Harbor, Aleutians and Kodiak

Dear Valued Customer,

Alaska Marine Lines has filed with the Surface Transportation Board for a general rate increase for Alaska; the increase is 7.5% and will become effective on December 11, 2022. This filing applies to STB AKMR tariff 315B. Additionally, Rule 942 (Terminal Charges) rates will be adjusted as follows:

- Dutch Harbor Terminal Handling Charge (northbound only): \$20.00 to \$370 per container
- Kodiak Terminal Handling Charge (northbound only): \$20.00 to \$400 per container
- Dutch Harbor Marine Assessment Fee: \$25.00 to \$129.00 per container

Local trucking and other accessorial charges in STB AKMR tariff 100A will also be adjusted on the same date. These increases are necessary in order to continue to provide the consistent and reliable level of essential service that our customers and communities rely on.
