

L-382 Hercules

Hercules Capabilities Include:

- Accommodates 8 non-contoured pallets or containers with dimensions of 108 inches in length, 88 inches wide, and 96 inches high for pallet positions 1 through 7; the 8th position is 108 inches in length, 88 inches wide, and 76 inches high
- Maximum payload is 48,000 lbs

- Straight-in loading through rear cargo ramp door
- Truck-bed height loading; ramp is adjustable to any position
- Drive-on, drive-off loading for vehicles and heavy equipment (rolling stock)
- Capable of transporting Connex boxes
- Self-contained auxiliary power; minimum ground support

- required for aircraft systems, offloading, and onloading
- Self-contained winch for loading/ unloading cargo
- Aircraft can back up under its own power
- Short and unpaved runway takeoff and landing

Scheduled Service

With the ability to land on unimproved airstrips and the flexibility to carry payloads up to 48,000 pounds of palletized or break-bulk freight, our Hercs can meet a wide range of requirements and tight deadlines. We offer regular service to key hubs in Western and Northern Alaska and heavy lift and outsized charter services worldwide. Whether it's a small package, bypass mail, or a load of construction materials, you can count on our reliable service schedule to provide the lift you need.

Our Hercs can be reconfigured to handle odd or large pieces that a normal 737 or DC-6 can't handle. We carry everything from mail and groceries to cars and boats within Alaska through scheduled weekly service. Scheduled year-round service is available from Anchorage

to Bethel, Nome and Kotzebue and flag stop service to any community with a runway. Flights to Bethel are scheduled Tuesday through Saturday and to Nome and Kotzebue on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.

Our intrastate air freighter service provides a variety of departure and arrival times for your convenience. We offer backhaul rates and flag stop service to the communities of Deadhorse, Kodiak, Iliamna, Emmonak, St. Paul, St. George, Dutch Harbor/Unalaska, McGrath, Galena, Cold Bay, Adak, Cordova and Yakutat.
